Could you tell us what you think about our software, 3DESIGN?

It is really nice, has many functionalities. The user can create easily the model in his/her mind.

What are these functionalities you liked?

You said Parametric, I have never heard before that the software for jewellery like 3Design is parametric. I liked it very much because designers always need to be very flexible on their design. They would like to feel so that they can change their model in every step. The other thing is that; the logic is like HYBRID modelling. There is another thing which is impressive for me, the user always work in solid mode so no need to make shading every time. Also 3Design is working very fast.

As you are a teacher what do you think about modelling with CAD systems?

Our students can create their designs in reality but it depends on the software capabilities. As I have seen, with 3Design we are more flexible on our designs.
