From September 12th -16th, 2005, our **3DESIGN** expert team from Vision numeric along with local reseller Comgraph provided an expert training session to **JARAD** project students. The **JARAD** project's goal is the promotion of new technologies among the jewellery industry complete with the education and training of these professionals. The program provided for 5-day training for a group of students managed by 2 professors from the university.

The **3DESIGN** team offers teaching for the professors at the *University*. Already acknowledged **3DESIGN** users, they were eager to discover the V4 functionalities of the new version during this expert training organized exclusively for demanding students.

Students present at this 1st expert session were more than familiar with **3DESIGN** as they had already participated into previous courses presented by *Comgraph*. The regular course for **3DESIGN** begins with a basic training session followed by advanced training and finally the expert session. The *Vision numeric* team who led the training came back enthusiastic about the overall level the students demonstrated.



With this generally high practice level, the session was the opportunity to focus onto specific applications with tutorials as support materials. As mentioned by users – beginners or experts -, **3DESIGN** is easy-to-use and its work environment and functions are intuitive. "3D representation is a true help when it comes to designing and it boosts my creativity!" explains an expert student.

Free form sketch, sweeping, duplication, draft kit and the distortion tools are among the students' favourites.
